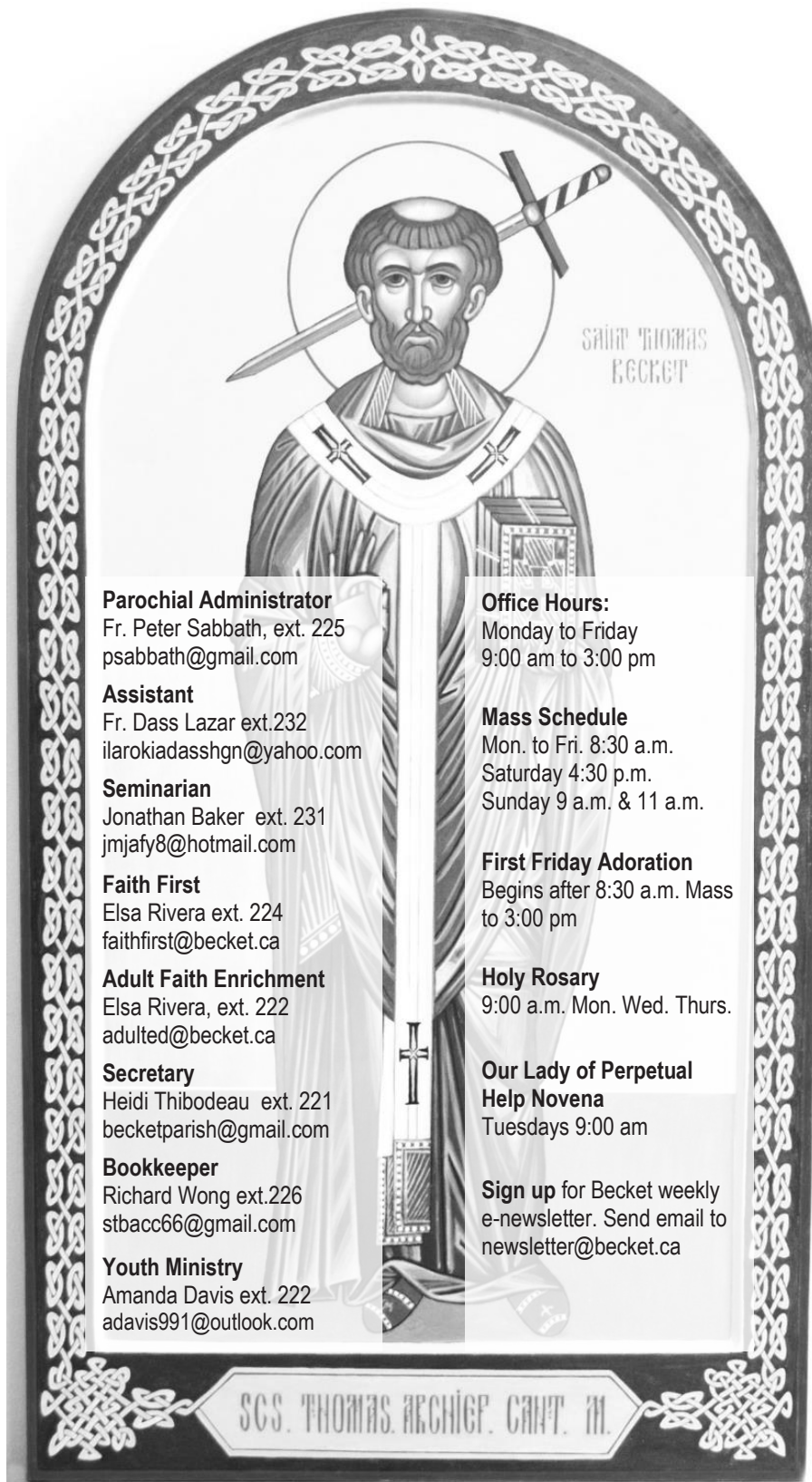

"Christ is Risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!"
"He is Truly Risen, Alleluia, Alleluia!"



With these joyous words Christians have greeted one another on Easter Day for nearly two thousand years. And every Easter the words proclaim anew the faith and hope of every Christian in the Good News of God's profound love of mankind, a love which conquers death. Mass on Easter Day is the most splendid and exuberant celebration of the Church. For this is the Sunday of Sundays, the day of Resurrection of Christ, the centre and foundation of our faith. As Saint Paul said, "If Christ be not risen, your faith is in vain" [I Cor. 15:14, 17]. Thus Easter is the pinnacle of all feasts of the Church year, which began with Advent, or the expectation of the coming of the Messiah, sent by God to provide the means

for our Salvation. The culmination of the entire liturgy is the Easter feast. Families who attend Mass on Easter Day join millions of Christians all over the world—past and present—in joyous affirmation of our redemption through the love of Christ, our hope of salvation, and our faith in the resurrection from the dead and the life of the world to come.

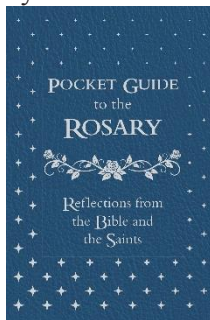
Every element of the festive celebration of Mass on Easter Day resounds with the great Alleluia, the triumphant word of praise for God proclaimed by men and angels. Every Sunday is a celebration of the Day of the Lord's Resurrection. Every celebration of Mass commemorates all the Easter Mysteries, the Lord's Supper at which Christ instituted the Eucharist, the sacrifice of Christ on the Cross and His Resurrection, the historic events on which Christianity is based. Every Sunday, then, is a "little Easter." Every Sunday is Christ's feast day. This is why Catholics are seriously obliged to participate in the Church's celebration of Mass on Sundays. From the earliest days of the Church, Mass was on the first day of the Jewish week. The word Sunday, *dies solis*, or "day of the sun" is a pre-Christian word retained by the Church because it emphasizes the belief that Christ is the "Sun of Righteousness." Saint John, in Revelation 1:10, refers to the *dies dominica*, "the Lord's day."

Pocket Guide to the Rosary: Reflections from the Bible and the Saints

- How to truly meditate on the mysteries on the Rosary.
- Major saints’ methods to pray the Rosary.
- Carefully chosen biblical passages to reflect on for each mystery.
- An overview of each mystery, with biblical quotes to help you establish context and focus your mind
- Insight on each mystery from the writings of the saints and Church Fathers
- Personal applications for each mystery, so you can further apply these mysteries to your own life and invite God to be a part of it

The guide begins with an introduction from Matt Fradd on the importance of the Rosary. This is followed by four sections exploring the Mysteries of the Rosary. Also included are additional prayers in English and Latin that help focus devotion during prayer time.

Matthew Fradd is Australian by birth and Catholic by choice. After experiencing a profound conversion at World Youth Day in Rome in 2000, Matthew committed himself to inviting others to know Jesus Christ and the Church He founded. He's worked in full-time law ministry in Australia, Canada, Ireland and the U.S, and been a guest speaker, writer, blogger, and radio guest on the BBC, EWTN, The Irish Morning Show, and Catholic Answers Live, where he has shared his personal story of sin, redemption, and healing to people all over the world. He is host of the popular podcast °Pints with Aquinas° and lives with his wife and four children in Florida.
